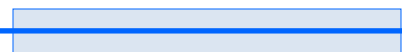
We would like to extend a special "Thank You" to all who made the event possible. The donations and contributions were much appreciated

Repair of Crows Nest Roads

The Roads Committee collected estimates to repair (patch) approximately 7,700 square feet of surface area on Crows Nest Drive, Leeward Drive, Widows Walk Court, and Windjammer Lane. The repair areas have been marked with white paint and will be cut, excavated, and filled with 3 inches of asphalt. Other cracks in the pavement will be hot sealed by the

asphalt contractor. The total cost for this work is expected to be less than \$35,000 and will be paid from the Private Road and Gate Reserve Fund. The Board has authorized AMG to contract and manage the work. We expect completion within 90 days. (Yardarm Court will be repaired by the Development Company.)

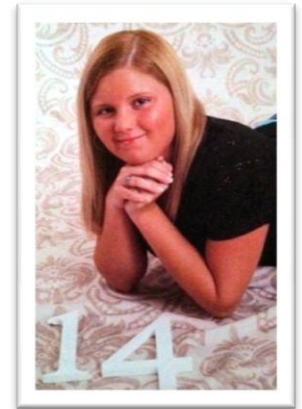
Winston-Salem Senior Games
