## **Pool Policy**

## **Availability and Access**

- The pool is open daily 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. during pool season
- Adult-only swim is 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. daily.
- The pool is for private use of members and their limited guests only.
- Members and guests agree to use the pool at their own risk.
- All users of the pool must wear appropriate swimming attire.
- Infants must wear a disposable swim diaper or a diaper covered by separate rubber pants.
- Everyone should vacate the pool and pool area during thunderstorms and other times of inclement weather, or for any other safety-related issue.
- In case of emergency, use the red emergency phone located on the clubhouse wall between the doors to connect directly to emergency services.
- AED is located on the next to the front door on the column.

## **Requirements and Restrictions**

- No diving.
- Adults over the age of 18 must be present to supervise children under age 14.
- No one should not swim alone.
- Nighttime swimming is prohibited by order of the Rockingham County Environmental Health. Pool closes at 8 p.m.
- No persons using excessive alcohol or under the influence of drugs should be on the deck or use the pool.
- Do not use the pool if you have a skin, ear, or nasal infection or any communicable disease.
- Pets and animals are not permitted in the pool or on the deck.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the pool or within the pool area.
- No smoking or vaping in the pool area.
- Running, boisterous or rough play is prohibited.
- It is recommended that individuals shower to remove any debris including skin cells and loose hair prior to entering the pool.
- It is recommended to use toys specifically made for the pool (e.g., noodles, waterproof balls, etc.)
- Avoid small toys that could get stuck in the pool drains or skimmers.
- Large toys that could interfere with other residents' enjoyment should be used at your discretion depending on how crowded the pool is.
- It is the responsibility of members and guests to retrieve their toys and other items before leaving the pool area.
- Avoid wearing Band-Aids in the pool.
- Be cognizant of your hair ties, as these could wind up in the pool drains.
- When using the grill, please adhere to the details posted and be sure to turn off the gas when not in use. A gas shut-off safety valve is located behind the right-hand door of the grill.
- Be sure to clean up ay messes including chairs, cushions, and throw trash in the garbage can outside of the gate.
- Furniture should be returned to its original location and umbrella closed following use.
